Energy Review

Our work on energy is coming to an end. In approximately one week the grade 1 students will show what they have learned over the last two and a half months. Below is a list of the main concepts we have learned for this unit, these are the things each grade 1 student should know.

- Energy is what makes things happen (move, grow).
- An energy chain is a picture showing how energy is passed from one thing to another (starts with the sun, then the plants, then the animals, then possibly more animals).
- Plants need sunlight to grow and survive.
- There are different sources of energy (gasoline, the sun, wind, food, muscle, electricity, etc).
- There are several possible outputs when energy is used (movement, heat, light, sound, growth, etc).
- Energy is not something that is unlimited; we need to try to save it.
- Life would be very different if we did not have some of our energy sources (no sun means no life, no electricity means no TV, computers, etc).
