Topic: What is Science?

Lesson

- Introduce myself, talk about Japan, engineering etc.
- Have students discuss "What is science?" in small groups
- Each group to present one idea * short
- As a class brainstorm ideas about the four strands in the curriculum
 - ① Life Systems - Growth and Changes in Plants
 - ② Structures and Mechanisms - Strong and Stable Structures
 - ③ Energy and Matter - Forces Causing Movement
 - ④ Earth and Space - Soils in the Environment
- Talk about topic in general, then specific to grade

Topic: Title Page

Lesson

- Review the four topics for grade 3 science
 - ① Growth and Change in Plants
 - ② Strong and Stable Structures
 - ③ Forces Causing Movement
 - ④ Soils in the environment
- Give each student a blank piece of paper
- Students are to make a title page, writing "Science", then adding pictures relating to topics
- Title pages must have name - highly visible
- Title pages are glued to front of science folders
